- We cannot exchange a winning cap color with another cap color (Ex: If someone gets green, they cannot exchange for a red) There are just enough caps for each prize (except candy) and it will throw the game off if we switch prizes.
- Numbered Prizes cannot be exchanged.(Ex: If they choose #3, they have to take the #3 prize) We cannot offer exceptions to this rule.
- Have participants use hand sanitizer before picking their caps.
- Only ONE cap winner is allowed behind the table to pick their prize. We have to enforce this because of COVID rules.
- Once caps are unwrapped please place coloured caps in designated bins.
- Yellow= CANDY! Please give away treat bags first. When those are gone, allow a Yellow winner to choose two candies or chips per cap.
- Because we have so much candy, you can refill yellow caps every so often. Extra tin foil is available to re-wrap.
- When the cash box gets full, we will ask that you take a deposit to the Rink Coordinators Room.
  - o 1)Use envelops provided in the bottom of the box
  - o 2) Place cash in it and seal it.
  - o 3)Write the amount, and sign your name
  - o 4) Take to Rink Coordinator who will keep it safe until we pick it up
